	All signs of organic growth should then be removed with a scraper or stiff, bristle brush, not wire.
	Wash surfaces and allow to dry. Heavy long established organic growth is best removed by
	pressure washing between 1500-2000 psi (102-136 bar), wet or dry grit blasting. Care must be
	taken not to damage the underlying surface.
	Take care not to allow residues to run directly into fresh watercourses
CLEANING	Return surplus material to container. Wash tools & equipment with clean water or a warm soapy
	solution & rinse immediately after use.
STORAGE	Store upright and secure. Store in secure dry conditions inaccessible to children or animals.
